

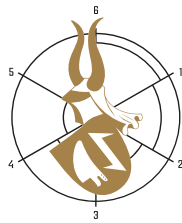

Das Bouquet unterstreicht von Anfang an einen Fokus auf Frische, würzige Nuancen und rote Beeren, ergänzt durch eine subtile rauchige Note. Der Ausbau nimmt seine Rolle als olfaktorischer Begleiter gelassen wahr. Er ist nur dazu da, um zu unterstützen, nicht um zu dominieren. Am Gaumen zeigt der Wein eine gewisse Fülle. Er wird von samtigen, perfekt eingebundenen Tanninen getragen, die durch ihre Art glänzen, ihre Kraft einzubinden und eine subtile Grundlage zu bieten. Eine schöne Hommage an Felix Peters mit einem Wein, der seine Authentizität und seine Herkunft in den Vordergrund stellt!

VDP.GROSSE LAGE

In these wines, the concept of terroir is taken to the very pinnacle of quality. They come from world-famous vineyards that produce exceptional grapes and have been recorded on centuries-old maps. They uniquely reflect the distinctive character of the vineyard, the particular nature of the soil and the superb skill of those who have often been familiar with the vineyard for many generations.

HISTORY

The 2024 vintage marks the first release of the Zellerweg am Schwarzen Herrgott Pinot Noir – a wine very close to our hearts and a tribute to our dear friend Felix Peters. When Felix founded his own winery, we helped him in his search for a suitable vineyard. He found a special plot, which he replanted with Burgundy clones and tended with incredible dedication. We have now taken over this vineyard and wish to preserve the memory of Felix with this Pinot Noir. That is why his name will continue to feature prominently on the label every year.

ORIGIN

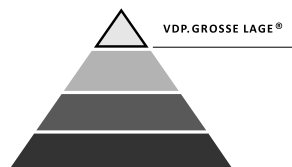
The Zellerweg am Schwarzen Herrgott is situated at an altitude of 240 metres. The solid limestone subsoil, which becomes increasingly darker with depth, and the unique microclimatic conditions are characteristic of this site.

VINIFICATION

The grapes are selectively harvested by hand, gently fermented spontaneously in oak vats and carefully pressed after approximately 10 days. The wine matures in second-use French barriques.

TASTE

The complex structure characteristic of Pinot Noir is a result of the barren limestone terroir. Yields are correspondingly low, producing concentrated and profound wines. Refreshingly crisp, with juicy fruit on the palate and vibrant
