Hohen-Sülzen lies in the Eisbach Valley, which as its name suggests features a cold highlands brook flowing down from the Donnersberg massif. This topography has a significant influence that is most pronounced on cooler evenings. The temperature fluctuations between day and night are greater in Hohen-Sülzen than in our other districts. Wines grown here maintain an incredible freshness, elegance and pleasant acidity despite the high ripeness levels in the fruit.

This Riesling beautifully reflects these unique conditions: ripe fruit aromas of sweet peach and juicy apricot dominate the nose and palate, followed by the earthy notes of tobacco, dried herbs, and a touch of licorice as well. This beautiful balance of fruit and minerality is one of the defining features of a Hohen-Sülzen wine: cool soil and warm fruit. On the palate it is both precise and playful as well as elegant and long.

The VDP classifies the vineyards of its members, with the finest divided into "Grosse Lagen" and "Erste Lagen" sites. Starting with the 2018 vintage, our Hohen-Sülzen Riesling will bear the VDP. AUS ERSTEN LAGEN classification, as only grapes from classified Erste and Große Lagen sites can be used in this wine.



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
