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WINE

The grapes come from our Pinot Noir vineyards in Hohen-Sülzen. After 6 years of ageing on the lees, we have disgorged the VDP. sparkling wine with a light dosage.

FLAVOUR

With a bright yellow and silver rim, it flows radiantly and clearly into the glass, the delicate perlage rising in a steady thread. A pleasantly warm aroma of sourdough bread crust and warm brioche, followed by green almonds and hazelnut shells. The warm flavours of the long yeast storage are underlaid with a fine red fruitiness, reminiscent of the apple peel of chubby red apples, dried fruit and a hint of cherry blossom. These are accompanied by delicate citrus notes of grapefruit zest and a hint of smoke in the top note. The first sip is gripping, with delicate and dense mousseux, focused, taut and straightforward, with vertical, ripe acidity. Animating and driving, with a gently pulsating bass on the palate. Slightly mellow, ripe notes are flanked by fine phenolics and aromatically noble bitter substances, underpinned by a rich extract that provides a certain juiciness while maintaining a firm structure. Medium-bodied with a balanced interplay of acidity, mousseux and extract, stimulating with a fine, chalky minerality on the finish.
