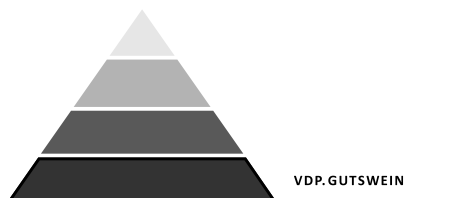
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Hohen-Sülzen lies in the Eisbachtal. This uplands brook flows from the Donnersberg massif and exerts a significant climatic influence on the valley. While days in the Wonnegau can be very hot, the cool nights dictate greater temperature swings than in other districts. The wines are characterized by their fully ripe fruit, fine spice and delicate acidity. The Weissburgunder is wild fermented, 80% in steel and 20% in large barrels.

Shades of yellow linger together with crisp notes of stone fruit redolent of pears and small quince with green hazelnut and pale blossoms. Clarion flavors on the palate, linear with distinctive fruit, balanced body and delightful drinkability. The straight forward sipper for every day, especially with light fare, salads or vegetable dishes.
