

WINE


Hohen-Sülzen is situated in the Eisbachtal. This stream in the low mountain range rises in the Donnersberg massif and has a significant climatic influence on the valley. The Weissburgunder benefits from the heat-storing limestone soils.

VINIFICATION

The wines are characterised by their fully ripe fruit, delicate spiciness and filigree acidity. The Pinot Blanc was fermented spontaneously and 80% aged in steel and 20% in tonneaux.

TASTE

Shades of yellow linger together with crisp notes of stone fruit redolent of pears and small quince with green hazelnut and pale blossoms. Clarion flavors on the palate, linear with distinctive fruit, balanced body and delightful drinkability. The straight forward sipper for every day, especially with light fare, salads or vegetable dishes.
