Hohen-Sülzen lies in the Eisbach Valley, which as its name suggests features a cold highlands brook flowing down from the Donnersberg massif. This topography has a significant influence that is most pronounced on cooler evenings. The temperature fluctuations between day and night are greater in Hohen-Sülzen than in our other districts. Wines grown here maintain impressive freshness, elegance and racy acidity despite the high ripeness levels in the fruit.

“LEOPOLD” (named for one of Carolin & H.O. Spanier’s two sons) illustrates the incredible potential for Silvaner in Rheinhessen: enticing aromas of fresh summer herbs such as lavender and basil underscored with subtle notes of honey. The palate is a force of epic proportions: lush and opulent with a sleek, taut body and an incredibly playful acidity. Yet this big wine moves with remarkable delicacy. For all the tension on the palate, a stunning creaminess prevails, mingling into a lithe, elegant and deliciously drinkable style.
