The Kirchenstück is our flagship in Hohen-Sülzen. There are very old vines, which are already mentioned in documents before the 30-year war. Her original name was Griebelsteyn-and this vociferous name is very apt. For the edition of the Kirchenstück consists of soft, limestone stones, which can be torn between your fingers. And this is also the secret of the Kirchenstück: The vines have a good nutrient supply, but the undersoil is extremely chalky. In this way, the grapes can develop an opulent fruit without appearing one-dimensional. The vines for the Große Lage Kirchenstück have an average age of 35 years.

Delicate and multi-layered-carried by an opulent fruit sweetness, which is wonderfully captured by the barren soil and the stony aromas and does not make them appear superficial. The concentrated acidity gives this wine an enormous complexity and play.



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
