The grapes for our “new” Spätburgunder come from the Burgweg, a world-class Bodenheim vineyard whose history can be documented at least as far back as 1364. The site is known for its distinctive composition, with a high concentration of limestone below a light, sandy topsoil. Pinot grapes are happiest when they have the proverbial “pieds chauds” - warm feet - and the Burgweg is ideal for this. Its slightly loamy sand warms quickly during the day, which promotes even ripening in the grapes. The high concentration of dissolved limestone lends the wines their minerality and ethereal elegance.

Aromas of dark forest fruit join the delicate barrel spice of French tonneaux. The high limestone composition of the soil also promotes a rare and enticing balance of elegant aromatics and taut mineral structure.

The VDP classifies the vineyards of its members, with the finest divided into “Grosse Lagen” and “Erste Lagen” sites. Starting with the 2018 vintage, the Bodenheim Spätburgunder will bear the VDP.AUS ERSTEN LAGEN classification, as only grapes from classified Erste and Große Lagen sites can be used in this wine.
