Nackenheim Riesling 2025

17.5 /20

An elegant nose of crisp citrus fruit and punchy, saline depth, even as something dark and savoury crouches beneath the freshness biding its time. On the palate, tensile and taut, the typical structural austerity of the site is transformed into a focused and energetic citrus charm. Crisp fruit edge, saline spice, cool, complex precision. On the finish, that juicy clarity persists. Unusually approachable this young, and all the better for it.

Nierstein Riesling 2025

17 +/20

A shy, closed nose of crisp yellow fruit. More deeply coiled than the Nackenheim, there is a stony drive and savoury concentration. All the raw material suggests grandeur, but the characteristic welcoming warmth has yet to appear.

Qvinterra Riesling trocken 2025

A nose of quince and white peach laced with a taut thread of spice. On the palate, concentrated and creamy, but a bitter edge intrudes on the otherwise juicy finish.

Chardonnay Réserve 2025

Expressive nose of white fruit, candied lemon peel and toast. Laser-focused acidity with the minerality doing the structural work, even as the oak serves rather than leads. Delicate floral finish.
